The National Intellectual Property Management Office ("NIPMO") refers to the submission of the University of Cape Town's ("UCTs") Formulae and Matrix for Full Cost Calculations (IP9 Form) on 2 August 2011. Furthermore, we refer to our letter of 30 July 2012 informing UCT that the submission is in line with the formal requirements as set out in Regulation 16 of the Intellectual Property Rights from Publicly Financed Research and Development Act ("IPR-PFRD Act").
